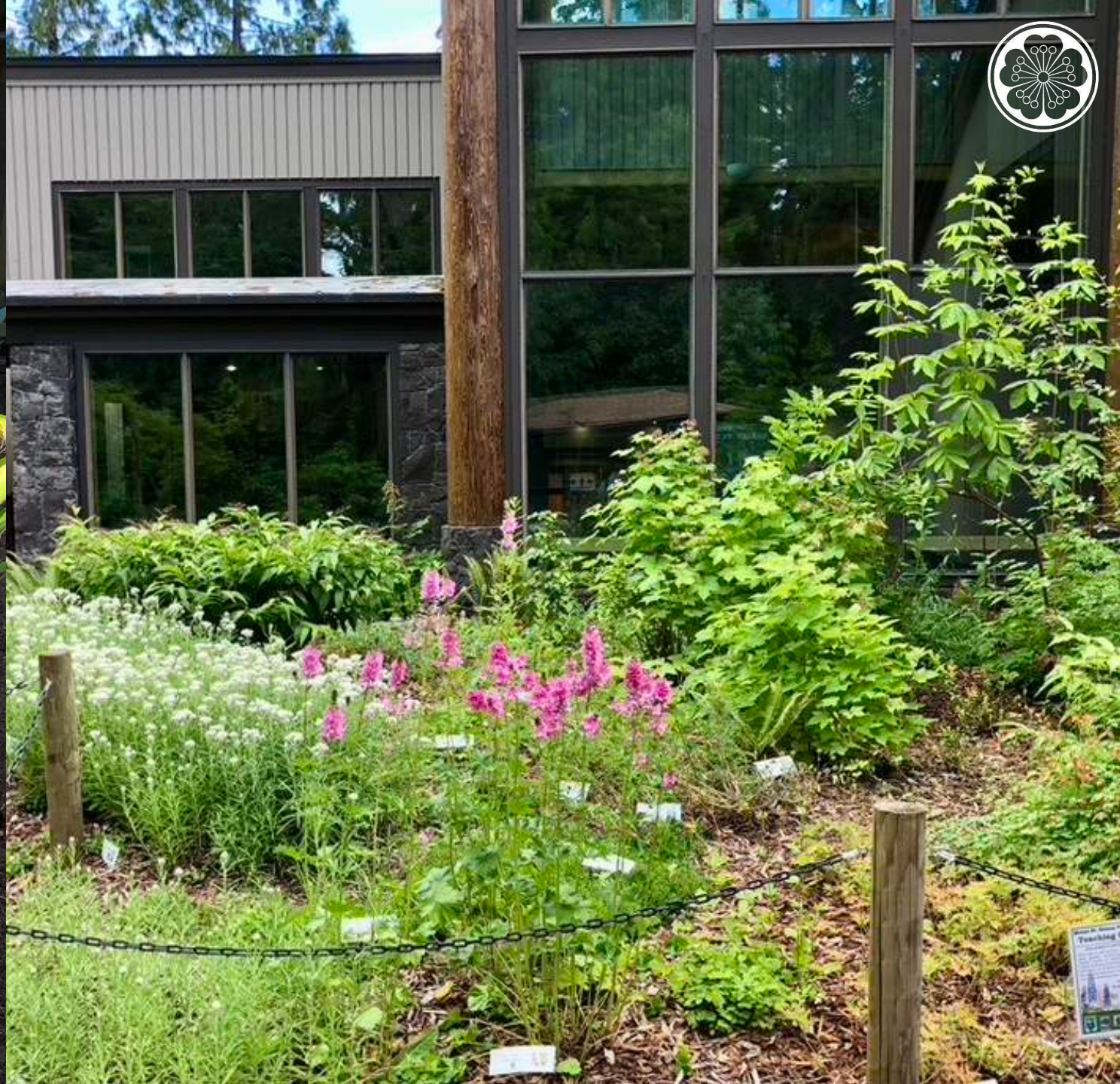
What is a Native Plant?
